

## Vehicle Report of Sale

**If you are the seller of a vehicle**, you must release interest by signing the Vehicle Certificate of Ownership (Title) and giving it to the buyer.

Complete and file a Vehicle Report of Sale within five business days of selling, trading, gifting, or disposing of your vehicle. This can help protect you from certain civil liabilities if the new owner does not transfer the title. You can file online at [www.InternetTabs.wa.gov](http://www.InternetTabs.wa.gov), free of charge, or at your local vehicle licensing office for a small fee.
